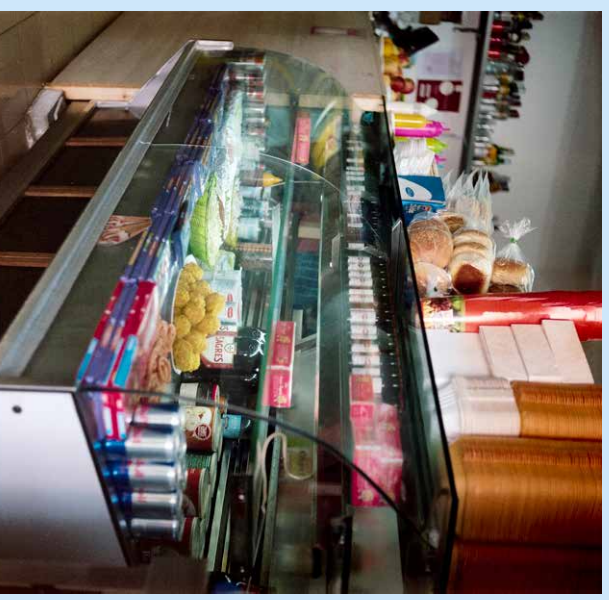
São Teotônio Never Sleeps
